Once again we have Zoetis DNA tested every bull. Genomic enhanced EPDS have increased accuracies of EPDs on yearling bulls without progeny and carcass information. We want our customers to be informed so you can make the best decisions for the future of your program. Our bull sale will be a live video sale utilizing the video feed of each and every bull selling without a "live" bull in the sale ring.
